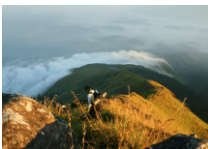
CHEMBRA PEAK

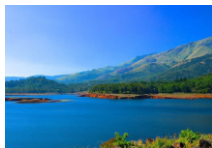
NEELIMALA VIEW POINT

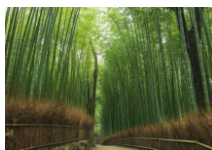
MEENMUTTY WATERFALLS

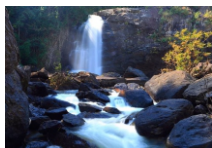
BANASURA SAGAR DAM
